

The **Florida Tax Credit Scholarship**, the **Family Empowerment Scholarship**, and the **AAA Scholarship Program** are available to families that need help paying for K-12 private schools and are based on financial need. These scholarships allow parents to find new and different learning environments for their children.

The **Gardiner Scholarship** provides educational funding for Pre-K-12 children with certain special needs. Students applying must show a medical diagnosis to qualify.

The **McKay Scholarship Program for Students with Disabilities** provides Florida students with special needs the opportunity to attend a participating private school. Students must have attended public school and have an official 504 or IEP to qualify.

The **Hope Scholarship** allows parents of children in public school to find a new learning environment for their child who is being bullied or a victim of violence.

Once a family's application is complete and approved, they can apply for an **SCS grant** through our FACTS online application.

Factors that impact grant awards include financial need, size of family/number of students enrolled at SCS, alumni status, and other considerations.
