



## SCS Elementary Drop Off & Pick Up 2020-2021

**Morning Drop Off \* K-5  
Unchanged time 7:30-8:00**

**PreK Drop Off  
7:45-8:00**

**Day 1 & Day 2 Special Accommodations  
for grades PreK, Kindergarten, and 1st grades.**

**Curbside drop off only.** Parents may not walk their student(s) in. Parents who MUST come in the building for essential business in the main office should drop their student off from the regular carpool line, continue forward through the carpool line and park in an open parking space. Parents may then enter the main building and complete their business. Parents must sign in at the front desk if they need to go to the business office or other administrative offices.

**Students arriving between 7:30 and 7:45** will walk to the back of the main building on the west side of the building. (Go through the main lobby and turn left). Students will sit in the covered area along the back of the building. It is anticipated that students will need to wear masks if distancing is not possible. Students will be supervised by a teacher. Please note this is a different location than last year's location. We are on the west side of the building this year instead of on the east side.

**PreK Students:** Families with PreK students will use the curbside drop off. The Patrols will walk those few PreK students to class via the outside door near the PreK playground on the east end of the building. PreK students who have an older sibling in 3rd, 4th or 5th, may have their older sibling walk them to their classroom. Siblings who walk the PreK student will be allowed to use the inside hallway **wearing masks**.

**AM Patrols** will wear masks provided by the school. They will keep this mask on their hook in the patrol closet in the main hall. After duty, all patrols will wash their hands before going to class.

**\*\*\*Day 1 and Day 2 - Special Accommodations for Grades PreK, Kinder, and 1st\*\*\***

Parents who want to walk these little learners into school on Day 1 and Day 2 may do so, using the following procedure. Park and use the center crosswalk. Do not enter the building. Turn right and go to the PreK playground where teachers and staff will greet students. Take your first day of school photos and say your goodbyes. Students will enter the building on the east side of the building. Parents will not enter the building. SCS staff will supervise, ensuring your precious little ones make it safely to their new classrooms for a year filled with learning, love, and laughter.



**Afternoon Pick up  
2:45 - 3:10 pm**

**Curbside Pick Up Only:** Cars will be parked along the entire front curb allowing us to take care of several cars at a time. Mrs. Kinsch, SCS staff, and all PM Patrols will be posted out front to facilitate pick up.

**PM Patrols** will wear masks provided by SCS. Masks will be kept in the patrol closet in the main hallway. After duty all patrols will wash their hands.

**PreK, Kinder, and 1st Grades** will remain in their classrooms until picked up by a Patrol.

**2nd-5th Grades** will be seated under the covered area along the back of the building. SCS teachers and staff will supervise. It is anticipated that students will need to wear masks if distancing is not possible. They will remain there until picked up by a Patrol.

**2nd - 5th Grade students with a sibling in PreK, K, or 1st grade:** The older students go to the classroom of the youngest sibling and wait outside the classroom door. An SCS teacher or staff will monitor this hallway at dismissal.

**Parents who MUST come in the building for essential business** will first have to drive through and pick up their child/children. **There will be NO walk up pick up.** After pickup, parents can park, and come in if they have essential business in the building.

Families that pick up more than their own children (example: cousins, etc.) will be assigned one patrol for each pick up card.
