#### Honors Courses Criteria

- 85<sup>th</sup> percentile in data taken from the MAP and PSAT data.
- Recommended by the instructor.
- Grade 87% or above in the subject area in the previous academic year.

#### Advanced Placement (AP)

- Grade 90% or above in the subject area in the previous academic year.
- AP Calculus: Must have completed AP Precalculus.
- AP Precalculus: Must have completed Algebra II H.
- AP Computer Science: Must have completed Algebra I and STEM/Computer Programming.
- AP Biology: Must have completed Biology H and Chemistry H.
- AP Literature or AP Language: Must have completed English IIIH or above with 90% or higher and/or score at least 500 on the Verbal portion of the PSAT
- Not required to take the AP exam, but if not taken will be required to take the end of year exam.
- Students are responsible for the cost of all AP tests.

#### Upper Level Science Courses:

- Biology and Chemistry must be completed before taking Anatomy and Physiology
- Must have Algebra II H before taking Physics H

#### Upper Level Math

- College Algebra and College Statistics must have Algebra II completed (80% or higher in Algebra II/ 70% or higher in Algebra II H) .
