

# SCS 2024 Pilot Summer Math Program



**PLEASE NOTE: This is a pilot program for students to prepare them for their upcoming math classes next school. Students who are enrolled in regular or honors math courses are recommended to complete these assignments, but are not required.**

**If you are in AP Precalculus or AP Calculus, you are required to complete the assignments posted below.**

## **Purpose:**

The purpose of these summer assignments are for students to work on prior math skills that will be needed for them to be better prepared for the next school year. Another purpose is for students to get a brief preview of the materials/topics that they will see in the upcoming school year.

## **Step One: Create/Sign into Khan Academy or Google Classroom**

If you are a current SCS student please use your school account. If you are new to SCS you may use your personal email address.

## **Step Two: Join the Course on Khan Academy**

Once you have signed into Khan Academy, you will use one of the class codes before to have the correct assignments for the appropriate class. In order to do this, you will need to go to your account dashboard, then select "Teachers" from the left-hand side menu, and then under "Join a Class" click
