- Full-time, armed school resource officer on campus
- Centegix Crisis Alert System
- Raptor Visitor Management System
- Background check of all faculty, staff, coaches and vendors
- Security cameras throughout campus
- Improved fences
- Automated locked gate
- Campus-wide locked door protocol

Thank you for supporting the safety protocols that are in place at SCS. Thank you for continued prayers for the Covenant School community and for the Sarasota Christian School community. Thank you for entrusting us with your children.
