Introduce yourself and ask if you are on track to graduate. ● Graduation Requirements: Review requirements with your advisor! ● Take the PSAT 8/9 or PSAT/NMSQT at SCS in October. All students will participate. ● Attend High School and Beyond for 8th grade going into 9th grade. 9th Graders will attend session with Advisor during WIN in January to discuss class choices for tenth grade. ● Complete your Academic Plan and be prepared to enter it into Overgrad (OG). <i>End of First Semester Grade 9/10</i> ● Be sure that your first semester grades reflect your ability, as your High School Transcript will follow you after High School Graduation. Do your best! ● Check your Grades and Assignments in FACTS DAILY! ● Participate in Community Service that is meaningful to you. Every SCS student needs a total of 150 hours to graduate. ● For further information, check here. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Get more involved in your favorite extracurricular activity and other areas of interest. Colleges look for depth of involvement in these areas. ● Schedule spring meeting with College and Career Advisor to review academic record and class choices for next year and run graduation check. ● Plan a meaningful summer activity. Consider Community Service opportunities, summer workshops, travel experiences, and delving into those extracurricular activities. ● Consider visiting a nearby college for a tour. ● Participate in the SVA High School Career Fair. ● Complete your Resume in Overgrad. ● Complete Self Assessments in Overgrad. ● Update your Academic Plan and prepare to enter it into Overgrad. ● Complete your Community Service Log and submit to office.
